## LO SCHERMO DELL'ARTE FILM FESTIVAL

A celebration of art in film, Lo Schermo dell'Arte is back with some of 50 Days' most diverse offerings. It opens with the acclaimed Francofonia from Russian director Alexandr Sokurov, which tells the story of how then-Louvre director Jacques Jaujard worked with a German official to save art treasures during Nazi occupation. Another highlight will be the premiere of Lisa Vreeland's Peggy Guggenheim, Art Addict, which sheds light on the famous art collector's tastes and patterns. Lo Schermo dell'Arte will also feature Festival Talks, which will include a November 19 conversation between British filmmaker Runa Islam and Paris-based researcher Riccardo Venturi, just before Islam's short films Empty the Pond to Get the Fish and Piece Unique.
